Planning

- There have been no planning applications over the summer break
- No sign of miller development progressing

Roads and Lighting

- Craigsheen Avenue: the drain at the top of the walking path is bringing up water causing running water down the street. Large pot holes have been created over the past couple of months. One pot hole has been slightly filled but with running water will soon be large again. Residents worried for safety now and for future cold weather as caused large ice blocks last year. Bailie McCabe is chasing up further work to be done to the drains.
- Bailie McCabe is further pushing the council to look at the bend on Cathkin Breas.
- After a recent drain investigation in the village 7 of the 10 drains were found to have concrete in them. Jet washing will not then clear them out so further work is needed.
- Bailie McCabe is going to investigate the flooding caused by the water run off onto Windlaw Road.
- Potholes on Kirk Road are very large and the pavement in front of the pharmacy has broken up making that walk dangerous.
- Roundabout at entrance to the village is very shabby looking
- Fly tipping at Pedmyre Lane remains an issue but is being taken away quickly
- Carmunnock Road pavement is overgrown

Transport

- 31 (Stuarts) last service has been cancelled. 10:30 cut off with no consultation. Councillor Vallis, McCabe and Morgan to write Stuart's a letter.

Linn Area Committee

- John raised the concern over the condition of the grounds at Linn cemetery. Bailie McCabe informed us that the grounds keepers being told to stay away from graves for fear of damaging items that have been left there. John had been told there was a significant reduction in grass cutting Staff

- The community council will pay a contribution of £50 towards Village Survey that recently took place.
- The community council would like to pass our condolences to the friends and family of Tom Morton who has sadly passed away. He will be greatly missed within the village and was an active member of the community.
- Simon is going to enquire about the blue car on busby road.
- Bailie McCabe has spoken to GCC about the use of the field behind Gallowhill road. The increase in dog walkers, quad bikes and scooters has become an irritant to those living there.
- Co. McCabe and Co. Vallis are going to let John know who the new country ranger is.
