### **Police Report:**

From the 4<sup>th</sup> of January to 3<sup>rd</sup> of February there was a total of 8 calls made to the police from the Carmunnock area;

- 4 calls in relation to abandoned vehicles in the area
- 1 call regarding a death in the community
- 1 call regarding a tree down blocking a road after Storm Eowyn
- 1 accidental 999 call.
- 1 call regarding a group of youths trying to gain access to an abandoned vehicle in the Carnbooth Hotel. A crime report has been raised and enquiries are ongoing with this matter.

### **Planning**

- David commented on the mess being created by the new build on Busby Road. Although the road is cleared regularly the pavements are becoming a mess. Derek is going to contact the contractors directly.
- Application has been put in for a single storey extension on 6 Picketlaw Drive.
- No news on Kittockside or Carnbooth developments.
- The gate house on Busby road has been getting fly tipping as well as down the lane.

### **Roads and Lighting**

- David raised the flooding and ice that is still being created on Busby road. He has tried chasing up this matter but no one seems to be resolving the issue. Councillor Vallis will look into this.

- Bailie McCabe, Bailie Morgan, Councillors Vallis and Carson have all been active in getting the drains unblocked and cleared. We have been told that clearing should be happening in April 2025.
- Pot hole on Busby road only recently filled and is reappearing. The pot holes are not being filled properly by subcontractors.
- Councillor Vallis is going to look into the standing water from the filled drains at Hillcrest.
- Cathkin Road will be resurfaced at the deep turn in March.

### Transport

- New electric buses have been complimented on their comfort and appearance.
- If getting the bus you should check latest times on FirstBus website or on their app.

### AOB

- Hydie came to talk to the CC about the work her and others on the Carmunnock Community forum have been doing to support and integrate residents in the village. The CC have agreed to take over the Carmunnock Website for £132 a year and to take over doing the survey work (production, distribution, collection and collation). The next meeting will include a presentation on the findings of the latest survey.
- No news about permanent Christmas tree coming from the infrastructure grant.
- An Instagram page is being created for the village to encourage younger residents to be more involved in the community and well as highlight the beauty and opportunities within the village.
- The new budget is being set on the 20<sup>th</sup> of February.
- The Carmunnock Heritage would like to encourage those of you who have done the heritage walk to leave reviews online.
- Councillor Morgan is going to look at the retaining wall on Busby Road as certain parts look close to collapsing.
- The Community Council would like to thank those who helped clean up the village and surrounding areas after Storm Eowyn. Councillor McCabe organised a clean-up.
